Meet on force majeure Kolkata: Vinit Kumar, chair-

Kolkata: Vinit Kumar, chairman, Dr Syama Prasad Mukherjee Port Trust (erstwhile Kolkata Port Trust), discussed force majeure conditions in shipping contracts and maritime trade and effects of the pandemic on shipping companies and the exim trade, at a webinar organised by the Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BCC&I).

Kumar explained the various steps taken in ensuring 80% work in both Haldia and Kolkata ports. Justice Soumen Sen elaborated the principles of force majeure law and the extent of shipping contract from shipbuilding to ship breaking/scrapping. "Previously, the wording of contract was sacrosanct but now relaxations are made to encompass influence of pandemic-related violations where, performance becomes impossible due to lockdown," he said.
