

Solar generation capacity in State will increase to 300 MW in a year: Min

KOLKATA: The solar generation capacity in Bengal will be increased to 300 MW within a year, Sobhandeb Chattopadhyay, state Power minister said on Thursday.

He was addressing a webinar at the 13th edition of Environment and Energy Conclave on Inclusive growth with resource efficiency organized by the Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry on Thursday. BCC&I has proposed to join COP 26 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change which will take place in Glasgow from November 1 to 12, 2021.

The state government has started using electric vehicles for public transport. The Power department is aiming at setting up good number of charging stations soon, he maintained.
