Course Summary:

- This short-term but intensive course will essentially take the learner through the basics of the German language.
- The course will enable the applicants to acquire knowledge of grammars, framing sentences and to speak, write and understand the language in its spoken form.
- To make the learning experience interesting and practically relevant, the orientation of this course will be interactive in nature.
- Lessons will be given through both theory and as practical activities like speaking and reading on a regular basis.

Outcome of the Course:

- Speech activities like self-introductions, greetings, enquiries and commonly relevant topics will be practiced in class in order to build up the confidence level of the learners.
- The course will effectively familiarize the learner with German grammar, basic vocabulary, and teach her/him how to construct and use short simple sentences for communication purposes.
- The Course will enable the learners to build association and strengthen relationships with the overseas collaborators.

Evaluation:

Evaluation will be done in two parts:

Total marks: 100 (divided into Mid-Semester and End-Semester)

- Mid semester: 30 marks, MCQ based online examination on Google Forms.
- End Semester: 70 marks, offline examination, divided into 4 parts:
 - Schreiben: Written Examination on Grammar: 25 marks
 - Lesen: Reading out unknown texts with correct pronunciation: 15 marks.
 - Sprechen: Speaking (Viva, Self introduction): 15 marks
 - Hören: Listening Comprehension: 15 marks

The online mode of teaching-learning was not unfamiliar as our students were already using the in-house developed Learning Management System, even prior to the pandemic. The shift to the online mode during the pandemic and blended mode of teaching-learning post-pandemic was rather seamless.

We have taught our students that all sectors including Education, Healthcare, Hospitality and even the Performing Arts have to undergo digital transformation in order to meet the demands of the changing scope of global work culture.

Infact, graduates from Humanities and Arts, Management and non-tech backgrounds in general will need to acquire skills of basic technology along with domain specific knowledge. SNU stresses on experiential learning. Our students across all streams are well versed in the basics of technology having been exposed to well equipped smart classrooms and smart student friendly infrastructure. SNU has set up a Digital Studio with state –of-the art infrastructure where students themselves Live Stream events shared across university's FB and Insta Page and Stories.

Students run a popular Podcast- SNU Radio, a very successful news digital news and infotainment platform called SNU Chronicle from this digital studio that help generate awareness about various social crisis and issues. SNU's digital team consisting of students and staff, infact, were the digital partner for International Kolkata Book Fair of 2022 and got exclusive rights to cover the event spanning two whole weeks.

Our students across all streams get to explore their creativity and expand their talent even during pursuing their degree. We offer a wide range of subject combinations under Choice Based Credit System, where students from a Computer Science Stream or Physics major can easily opt for Dance/Music/Painting as a generic elective subject.

Knowledge of Foreign Languages is always an added advantage in the industry in the near future. Our students are taught European and Asian languages viz French, Japanese, Mandarin, German, Italian, Spanish, as part of their curriculum and by the time they graduate, they are fluent in at least one Foreign language. Infact our students and faculty receive invitation from Foreign Consulates stationed in Kolkata to put up shows or to organize workshops for visiting foreign nationals. We also organize workshops in collaboration with these consulates where experts from their country visit us to conduct workshops and train our students in an art specific to the country.

At the same time SNU has come up with three new centres, Centre for Entrepreneurship Development, IPR, Innovation & Incubation Centre for Interdisciplinary Studies and Centre for New India Studies that will explore inter sectorial research and academics.

SNU has developed a global network. We have signed MoU with several universities of France, Italy, USA, UK, Germany, Australia, Bosnia, Russia, Spain, Poland, China, Singapore that help facilitate student exchange, aculty exchange and research scholar exchange. Infact, our students have already received scholarships from the Govt of Japan to pursue research in health science domain in Japan.

It has been our predominant mission to make every student be attuned to the demands of the society and implement ideas to solve crises. But most importantly, our students have been taught to implement their education to serve the community and society at large.
