









Mr. Valentin Makarov, President, St. Petersburg-based Russoft, stated that a number of Russian software companies are very keen to expand footprint and forge JVs in the BRICS nations and India appears to be the best potential partners for Russia to create and achieve technological goals. A total of 267 software companies from across Russia are part of Russoft, which was formed in 1999 with a consortium of only 10 entities. Around seven Russoft companies had 'stable partners' in India. The technology giants such as Microsoft, Intel, Dell and HP had development centres in Russia, and some of these companies had shut shop in the country after the invasion of Ukraine. Mr. Makarov also said that Russian IT companies can boost Indian firms with technological prowess- i.e. by including artificial intelligence (AI), automation of industrial production, cyber security, telemedicine and digital governance; by bringing AI in tax treatment, optimising traffic movement through software, economising electricity consumption and working on information systems for logistics. Mr. Makarov also emphasized on digital currency and a Rupee-Ruble payment mechanism to avoid dependence on U.S. dollar for international trade.

The session was followed by vibrant business-to-business meetings between the Russoft delegation and Indian companies.

The Chamber was delighted to have Ms. Rowan Ainsworth, Consul General, Australian Consulate – General in Kolkata; Mr. Hugh Boylan, Economic and Public Affairs Counsellor, Australian High Commission, New Delhi and Mr. Debarka Chakraborty, Principal Consultant, MN Dastur & Company (P) Ltd. Dr. Prabir De, Professor, Research and Information System for Developing Countries (RIS), New Delhi graced the session virtually. ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION ON "AUSTRALIA-INDIA ECONOMIC COOPERATION AND TRADE AGREEMENT"

The session was commenced with the formal Welcome Address by Mr. Abraham George Stephanos, President, The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Managing Director, Tata Steel Downstream Products Limited. He said that it is important for businesses to understand the opportunities unlocking from the trade agreement and the Chamber is actively acting as a facilitator.

Ms. Rowan Ainsworth, Consul General, Australian Consulate – General in Kolkata shared the overview of the Foreign Trade Agreement (FTA). Australia is the 17th largest trading partner of India and India is Australia's 9th largest trading partner. India and Australia, on 2nd April 2022, had signed an economic cooperation and trade agreement under which Canberra would provide duty-free access in its market for over 6,000 broad sectors of India, including textiles, leather, furniture, jewellery and machinery. This agreement is likely to be implemented in about four months.

Mr. Hugh Boylan, Economic and Public Affairs Counsellor, Australian High Commission, New Delhi highlighted benefits of the deal, which would help in taking the bilateral trade from \$27.5 billion at present to \$45-50 billion in the next five years. This is the first trade agreement that India has signed with a developed economy after more than a decade.

Dr. Prabir De, Professor, Research and Information System for Developing Countries (RIS), New Delhi shared his perspectives on possible impacts of FTA on industries in both Australia and India and its bilateral trade. He stated that India-Australia Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement is going to strengthen not only the bilateral trade between the two countries but also improve India's image in the world post-RCEP.

1. Introduction

- a. Recently, India has signed a historic trade agreement with Australia, the India-Australia Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement (Ind-Aus ECTA). The negotiations for India-Australia ECTA were formally re-launched in September 2021 and concluded on a fast-track basis by the end of March 2022.
- b. The pact will increase bilateral trade to \$45-50 billion in five years and create over one million jobs in India. Many labour-intensive Indian exports currently face a tariff disadvantage of 4-5 percent compared to competitors those with FTAs with Australia such as China, Thailand, and Vietnam.

2. What is Free Trade Agreement

A Free trade Agreement (FTA) is an agreement between two or more countries where the countries agree on certain obligations that affect trade in goods and services, and protections for investors and intellectual property rights, among other topics... Further,

- It is a pact between two or more nations to reduce barriers to imports and exports among them.
- Under a free trade policy, goods and services can be bought and sold across international borders with little or no government tariffs, quotas, subsidies, or prohibitions to inhibit their exchange.
- The concept of free trade is the opposite of trade protectionism or economic isolationism.
- FTAs can be categorised as Preferential Trade Agreement, Comprehensive Economic Cooperation

Agreement (CECA), Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA).

3. Existing Bilateral Trade Agreement executed by India

At present India has bilateral agreements with the following countries and blocs:

4. Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement with Australia

- It is the first Free Trade Agreement (FTA) that India has signed with a major developed country in over a decade.
 - In February, India signed an FTA with the UAE and is currently working on FTAs with Israel, Canada, UK and the European Union.
- The Agreement encompasses cooperation across the entire gamut of bilateral economic and commercial relations between the two friendly countries, and covers areas like:

INDIA-AUSTRALIA ECONOMIC COOPERATION AND TRADE AGREEMENT (IND- AUS ECTA)

- Trade in Goods, Rules of Origin.
- > Trade in Services.
- Technical Barriers to Trade (TBT).
- Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) measures.
- Dispute Settlement, Movement of Natural Persons.
- Telecom, Customs Procedures.
- Pharmaceutical products, and Cooperation in other Areas.
- ECTA provides for an institutional mechanism to encourage and improve trade between the two countries.



6. Basic features of the India and Australia ECTA

- The ECTA between India and Australia covers almost all the tariff lines dealt in by India and Australia respectively. Under this Agreement
 - India will benefit from preferential market access provided by Australia on 100% of its tariff lines (Please refer the Annexure).
 - Australia will also get market access in India on specified Tariff Lines. (Please refer the Annexure)
 - This includes all the labour-intensive sectors of export interest to India such as Gems and Jewellery, Textiles, leather, footwear, furniture etc
 - On the other hand, India will be offering preferential access to Australia on over 70% of its tariff lines, including lines of export interest to Australia which are primarily raw materials and intermediaries such as coal, mineral ores and wines etc.
- Under the agreement, Indian graduates from STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) will be granted extended post-study work visas.
 - Australia will also set up a programme to grant visas to young Indians looking to pursue working holidays in Australia.

7. How Trade Boost will take place between India and Australia



8. What is the Significance of the Agreement?

- It will provide zero-duty access to 96% of India's exports to Australia including shipments from key sectors such as engineering goods, gems and jewellery, textiles, apparel and leather.
- It will boost bilateral trade in goods and services to USD 45-50 billion over five years, up from around USD 27 billion, and generate over one million jobs in India, according to a government estimate.
- It will also give about 85% of Australia's exports zeroduty access to the Indian market, including coal, sheep meat and wool, and lower duty access on Australian wines, almonds, lentils, and certain fruits.

9. Way Forward

- Shared values, shared interests, shared geography and shared objectives are the bedrock of deepening India-Australia ties and the cooperation and coordination between the two countries have picked up momentum in recent years.
- Both India and Australia share a vision of a free, open, inclusive and rules-based Indo-Pacific region and cooperative use of the seas by adherence to international law including the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) and peaceful resolution of disputes rather than through unilateral or coercive actions.
- The India-Australia ECTA will further cement the already deep, close and strategic relations between the two countries and will significantly enhance bilateral trade in goods and services, create new employment opportunities, raise living standards, and improve the general welfare of the peoples of the two countries.








Free Health Camp @ 7 April @ Ruby General Hospital

Coding Workshop


The Coding Workshop was organised on 21st April, 2022. The workshop was organized for the students to give them hands-on experience with the coding concepts. The workshop was guided by

achievements of its faculty members and students in Research and Innovation. The ceremony was held on 21 April 2022 at the institute.










The English language Day Celebration
