The Financial Year 2022-2023 was marked with geo-political uncertainty, fuel disruptions, stock-market upheavals, talk of recession, runaway inflation and unrest in neighbouring countries. We have to acknowledge the resilience of the Indian economy which has stood its ground and India's growth story has even been a beacon of light for other countries to draw inspiration from in these unpredictable times.

The Union Budget, as per the Chamber, was ambitious in its tenets and stood on the twin pillars of wholesomeness and inclusivity. Reduction in Customs Duties and rationalisation of Direct Tax rates are expected to support the "Aam Aadmi" and MSMEs, the latter having been allotted an additional collateral free credit guarantee of Rs 2 lakh Crores. The new Millet Mission is of importance in the context of India's nutrition and water security. A 33% rise in Capex outlay is noteworthy, while major announcements on digitalisation have been made apart from meaningful steps having been taken to move India on the path of sustainable/green growth.

The State Budget saw allocation towards construction of old and new rural roads which would give a boost to the rural economy. Extension of exemption of agricultural cess for 1 more year and stamp duty Reduction extension for 6 more months are other meaningful proposals. Additionally, GST collections had been robust and the highest among Indian States.

In the past month, The Chamber had been holding relevant programmes for its stakeholders both at home and away. The Minerals Mining and Metals Conclave was held this year at Bhubaneswar. The Annual Flagship Manufacturing & MSME Conclave this year is also being held at Pune, one of the largest manufacturing hubs of the country. The Chamber is also taking a delegation comprising member stakeholders to Bangladesh this month to explore business synergies and investment opportunities.

A public impact event titled and symposium "Gendered Journeys: The trajectories of STEM students and graduates through higher education and into employment, in multiple global south contexts" was organized by The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCC&I) on 16th January 2023 at the Bengal Chamber Premises with support of the Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC, UK) international and multilateral grant .The "Gendered Journeys" project was Copartnered by the University of Glasgow, University of Rwanda and the Indian Institute of Management — Calcutta.

It was a unique attempt at co-creating meaningful conversations and transformative future practices around gender, inclusion, and STEM education between diverse partners from the corporate segment (including BCC&I who are the Knowledge Partners for the "Gendered Journeys" project), academic communities and public policy makers.

The main objectives of the summit were:

 To promote the research vision of expanding gender inclusivity in the context of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) related Higher Education in India, Rwanda and UK

- To create a impactful coalition of multiple stakeholders involving academic scholars, working professionals, student communities, public policy makers and those in leadership roles in Higher Education Institutions to expand sensitivity and awareness regarding gender inclusive norms and practices in the STEM fields.

India's struggle for freedom, is usually told from the perspective of the non-violent movement. Yet, the story of armed resistance to colonial occupation is just as important. Names such as Vinayak Savarkar, Aurobindo Ghosh, Rashbehari Bose, Bagha Jatin, Sachindra Nath Sanyal, Bhagat Singh, Chandrashekhar Azad and Subhas Chandra Bose are still widely remembered. Their story is almost always presented as acts of individual heroism and not as part of a wider movement that had any overarching strategy or significant impact on the overall struggle for Independence.

In reality, the revolutionaries were part of a large network that sustained armed resistance against the British Empire for half a century. They not only created a wide network inside India but also established nodes in Britain, France, Thailand, Germany, Persia, Russia, Italy, Ireland, the United States, Japan and Singapore. At various points, they received official support and recognition from the governments of some of these countries. Even the internal dynamics of the Indian National Congress of the time cannot be understood without the revolutionaries, who enjoyed widespread support within the organization. This was no small-scale movement of naive individual heroism but one that involved a large number of extraordinary young men and women who were connected in multiple ways to each other and to the evolving events of their times.

Revolutionaries tell their story, one that is replete with swashbuckling adventure, intrigue, espionage, incredible bravery, diabolical treachery and shockingly unpredictable twists of fate.

The initiative was partnered by MCKV Institute of Engineering; and Power Gilt Treasuries. The programme was very well covered in Media and well hugely appreciated and attended by 250 + participants.


#### **GNIHM ORGANIZES WORLD CAKE ICING COMPETITION 2023**

The Mechanical section includes boiler, furnace section, turbine section, pulverize, ID fan, FD fan etc. Electrical section including control room, switch-yard and the DM plant were demonstrated very nicely by the Shift Engineers.

#### Seminar on Education Career & Life by Department of CSE


