Reaffirming its commitment to strengthening India's Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), **The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BCC&I)** successfully organised the **5th Edition of World MSME Day 2026** on **27th June 2026** at **Williamson Magor Hall, Kolkata**. Held under the theme "**From Short-Term Support to Long-Term Structural Growth: Kolkata as Eastern India's Global MSME Gateway**," the conclave brought together policymakers, industry leaders, financial institutions, technology providers, academia and entrepreneurs to deliberate on strategies for building a more competitive, resilient and future-ready MSME ecosystem.

The conclave was inaugurated by **Shri Jagannath Chattopadhyay, Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge, Higher Education & Technical Education, Training & Skill Development Department, Government of West Bengal**, who highlighted the pivotal role of MSMEs in achieving the vision of **Viksit Bharat 2047**. Stressing the importance of industry-oriented skill development and entrepreneurship, he referred to initiatives such as the **PM Vishwakarma Scheme** and **PM SETU**, while also highlighting the State Government's efforts to strengthen technical education through **51 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)** across West Bengal to create a skilled workforce aligned with evolving industry needs.

Welcoming the delegates, **Mr. Supriyo Ghosh**, Chairperson, National MSME Committee, BCC&I, observed that while emerging technologies such as Artificial Intelligence are reshaping industries, values such as trust, ethics, creativity and collaboration will continue to define sustainable enterprises. **Mr. Abhijit Roy**, President, BCC&I, emphasised that achieving the vision of **Viksit Bharat 2047** requires a strong and competitive MSME ecosystem supported by innovation, technology adoption and deeper integration into national and global value chains. The inaugural session also featured thought-provoking addresses by eminent leaders from **Tata Steel Downstream Products Limited**, **Haldia Petrochemicals**, **PayNearby**, **TRISS**, **Munjal Institute for Global Manufacturing** and **Balmer Lawrie**, who shared perspectives on industrial competitiveness, sustainability, digital transformation, supplier development and collaborative growth.

The technical sessions addressed several dimensions of enterprise development. A dedicated session on **MSME Credit Linkage & Pension Awareness** brought together experts from leading financial institutions and the **Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA)** to discuss collateral-free lending, digital banking, financial literacy and retirement planning through the **National Pension System (NPS)**. Complementing the session, a **parallel PFRDA workshop** witnessed the participation of around 40 MSMEs from diverse sectors, particularly enterprises employing **20 or more workers**, offering practical guidance on NPS enrolment, pension planning and one-to-one advisory support.

Digital transformation remained a central theme throughout the conclave. Participants were introduced to the latest capabilities of **TallyPrime Release 7.1**, including AI-enabled accounting, GST compliance, connected banking, e-invoicing and business automation tools designed to simplify statutory compliance and improve operational efficiency. The event also witnessed the launch of the **Balmer Lawrie MSME Travel Booking Portal**, an exclusive corporate travel solution offering registered MSMEs simplified travel management, transparent pricing and reduced transaction costs.

Recognising the importance of building globally competitive enterprises, the conclave also featured discussions on **export facilitation, renewable energy adoption and industrial infrastructure**. Experts from the **Export Credit Guarantee Corporation of India (ECGC)** highlighted export risk management solutions, while representatives from **Tata Power Renewable Energy Limited** and **Solar Logics Private Limited** demonstrated how rooftop solar and clean energy solutions can reduce operational costs and improve sustainability. 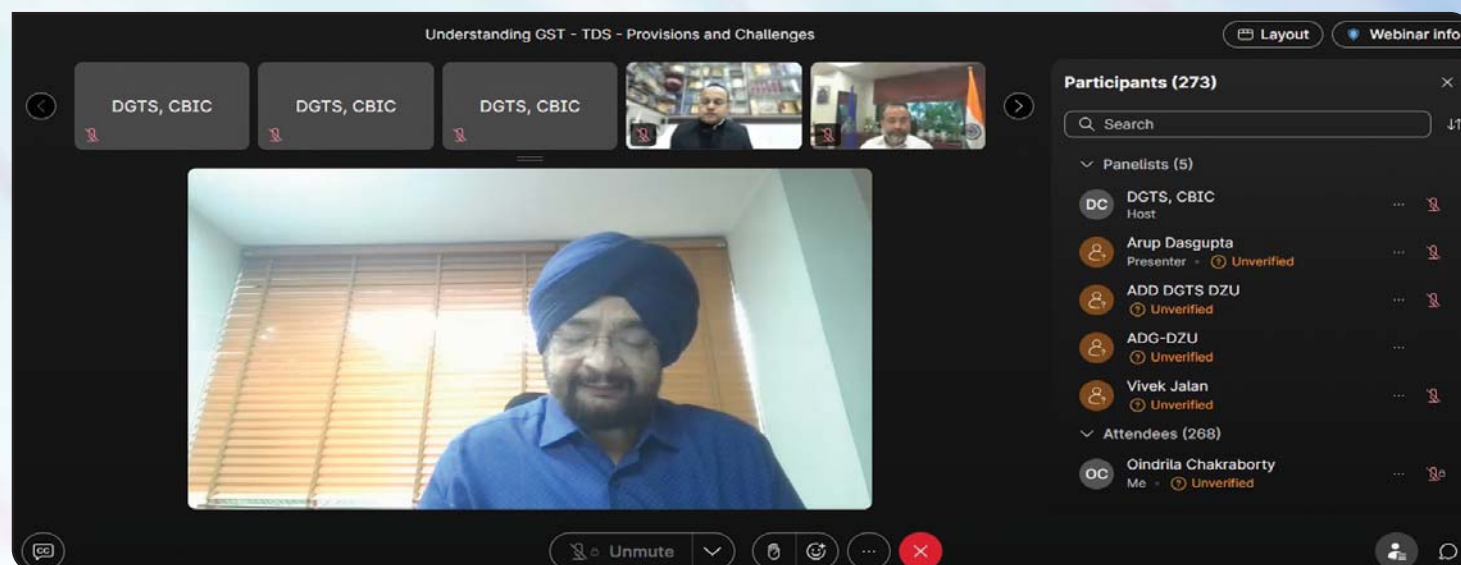
Shri Ravindra Joshi, Additional Director, DGTS, CBIC welcomed the audience and introduced the panelists for the webinar.

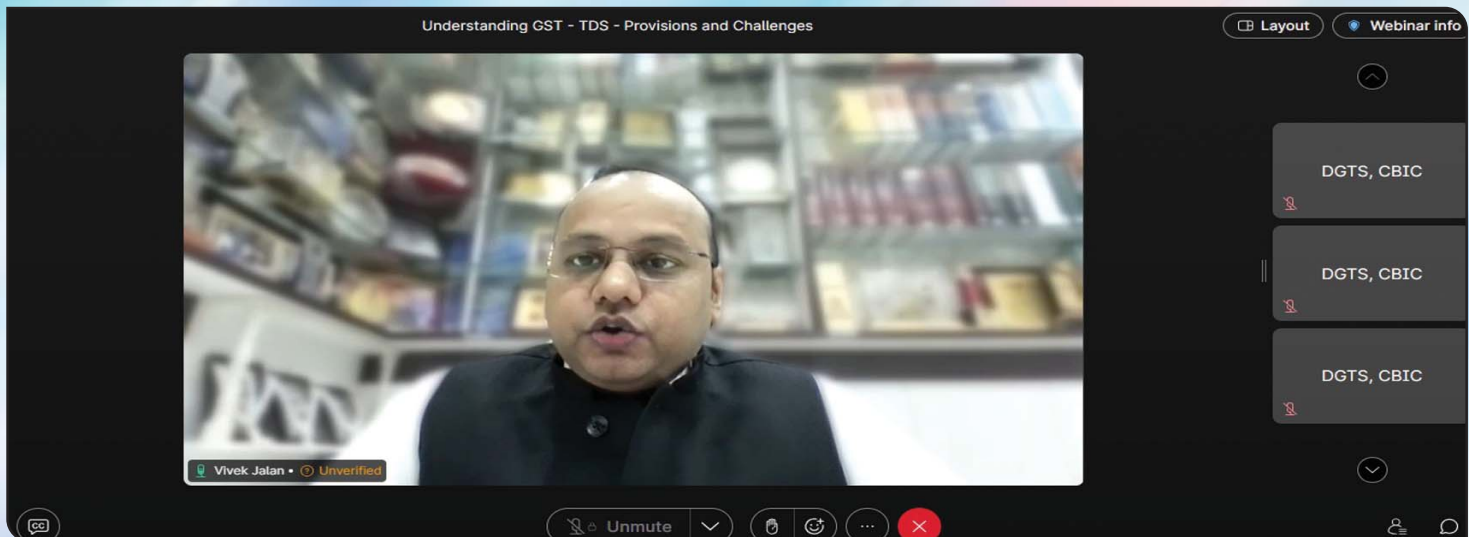

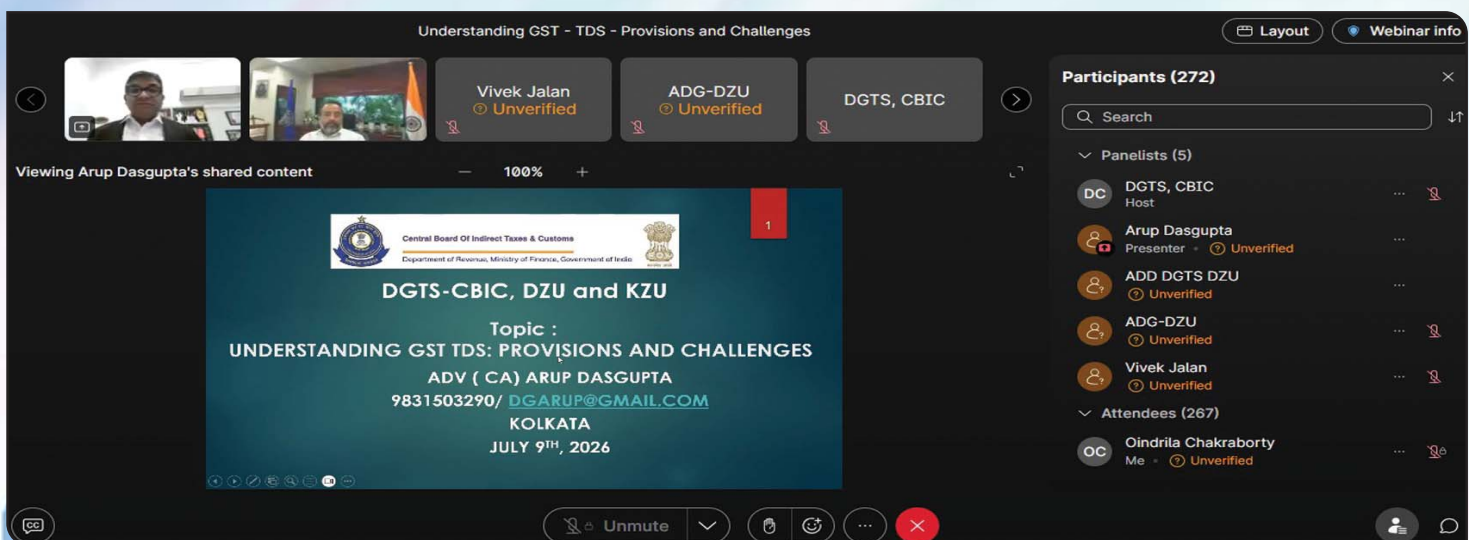

MoU BETWEEN BCC&I, INTUERI CONSULTING LLP AND ASIAN CONFLUENCE SIGNED TO POSITION EAST AND NORTHEAST INDIA AS INDIA'S GATEWAY TO THE INDO-PACIFIC

The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCC&I), in collaboration with Intueri Consulting LLP and Asian Confluence, organised a high-level Closed-Door Round Table Discussion on **"East and Northeast India : Gateway to the Indo-Pacific"** on **9th July 2026** at the historic premises of The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Kolkata.

The programme culminated in the signing of a landmark **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** between the three organisations, reinforcing their shared commitment to advancing the economic and strategic potential of Eastern and Northeast India within the Indo-Pacific region. The Round Table brought together diplomatic representatives from the United Kingdom, Australia, Thailand, Japan and Bangladesh, along with industry leaders from organisations including Gainwell, RPSG Group and Balmer Lawrie, as well as eminent academicians and policy experts.

The discussions focused on positioning East and Northeast India as a strategic gateway to the Indo-Pacific by leveraging the region's geographical advantages, strengthening regional partnerships and promoting sustainable economic growth through enhanced connectivity and collaboration. Deliberations also highlighted the importance of institutional cooperation, policy advocacy, multimodal logistics, resilient infrastructure, entrepreneur-to-entrepreneur partnerships and stronger engagement between industry, think tanks and government to create an integrated and inclusive regional ecosystem.

Participants also explored emerging opportunities arising from key infrastructure developments, including the **Matarbari**

Deep Sea Port in Bangladesh, the upcoming semiconductor manufacturing facility in Assam and West Bengal's proposed **Dadanpatrabar Deep Sea Port**, recognising their potential to strengthen regional value chains, improve connectivity and accelerate economic integration across the Indo-Pacific.

A key highlight of the programme was the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Intueri Consulting LLP and Asian Confluence. The partnership establishes a long-term collaborative framework for research, policy advocacy, stakeholder engagement and strategic initiatives aimed at positioning Eastern and Northeast India as an integrated economic gateway to the Indo-Pacific. It will also facilitate knowledge exchange, promote regional partnerships and support sustainable and inclusive economic development across the region.

The programme also marked the release of a comprehensive **Knowledge Paper** titled **"East and Northeast India : Gateway to the Indo-Pacific,"** offering insights into the region's evolving strategic and economic landscape while outlining pathways to strengthen regional connectivity, trade and investment.

The Round Table concluded with a shared commitment among government, industry, academia and strategic institutions to work collaboratively towards building a resilient, connected and prosperous Indo-Pacific, with Eastern and Northeast India playing a central role in driving the region's future growth.

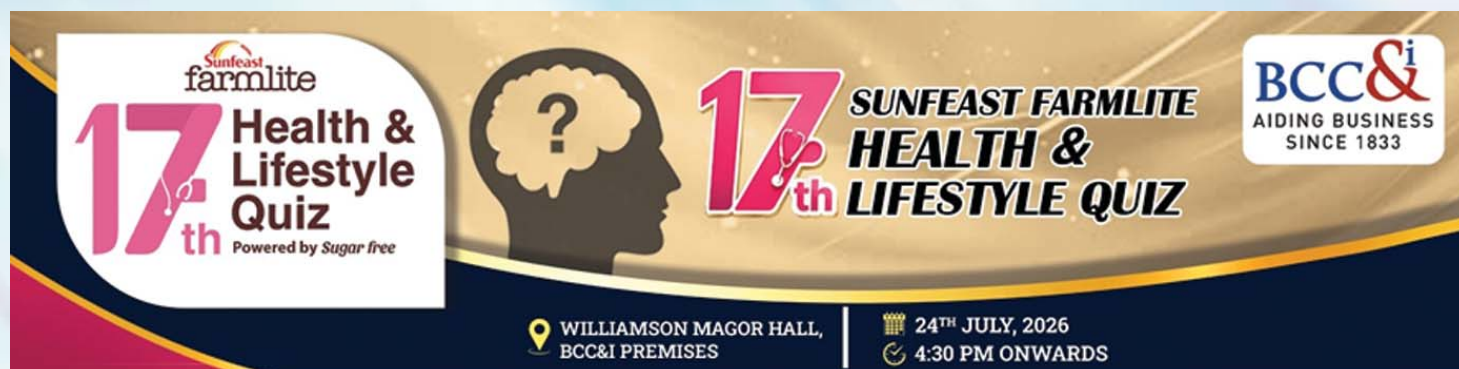

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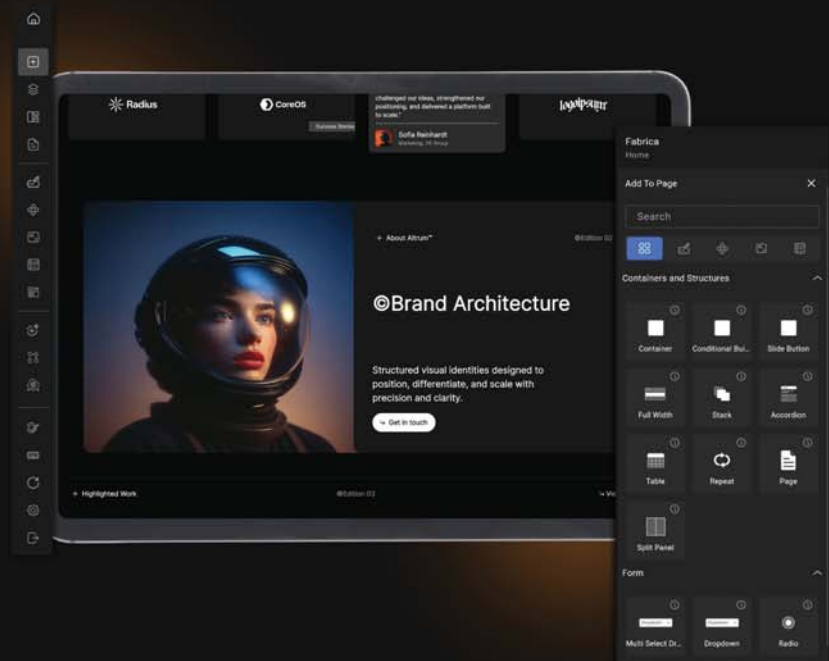
