TAIWAN EXPO 2021

Taipei World Trade Centre, Kolkata (TAITRA), in association with The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BCC&I), had organized Taiwan Expo 2021 from 27th to 29th October, on virtual platform. This Expo had exhibitors from different industrial sectors of Taiwan - Home life accessories, Industrial testing & safety equipment, Furniture hardware, Information communication, Tours & Travel to name a few. Some prominent Taiwanese companies which were present in the event included Jye Lian Technologies Ltd, Sheng Yuan Electric Co. Ltd., Bam Boo Lai Ltd., Kuching Travel Service Co, Yuden Tech, OncQue Corporation etc.

The main objective of the event was to develop bilateral trade relations between India and Taiwan and widen the connection between the two countries, both economically and culturally. This was done by conducting dedicated, one-to-one B2B meetings between the Taiwanese exhibitors and relevant and potential Indian buyers engaged in manufacturing, distributing and providing the same line of products or services. Through some intense primary and secondary market surveys, The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BCC&I) was able to connect with around 108 Indian units located across India. By informing them about the event and helping them realize how fruitful the meetings can be for them and India as a whole, The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BCC&I) was able to organize a total of 46 one-to-one B2B meetings.

The opening ceremony of the event was hosted in Taiwan. In Kolkata, the event was coordinated from the King's Bakery, Kolkata. The event commenced at 10.00 AM (IST) on 27th October and the opening ceremony was followed by the one-to-one B2Bs. A total of 18 meetings were conducted virtually on that day. Some eminent Indian organizations which were

a part of this event on 27th were **Damodar Valley Corporation** (DVC), Shapoorji Pallonji and Company Ltd., Vinayak Group, Klystron Electronics, SAGS Control Pvt. Ltd., Shree Ganesh Enterprise, Exciting Tales etc.

On 28th October, electrical goods wholesalers like HL Engineering Corporation, construction companies like Merlin Projects Ltd., Belani Group and Orbit Projects Pvt. Ltd., travel companies like Cirrus Adventures and Tour My India, bamboo construction and bamboo product companies like Go-Bamboos, Meera International, Manmayee handicrafts and companies like Navitus Controls, Cosmos Engineering Works, DB Products & Systems, etc were present in the meetings. A total of 22 meetings virtually were organised on this day.

29th October was the last day of the event on which, a total of 6 virtual meetings were conducted. On this day, sanitaryware wholesalers like Bengal Sanitations, electrical goods wholesalers like Ganguly Electricals, construction companies like Ambrus Construction, travel and M.I.C.E companies like Wizard Events and Sai Dot Com, companies like Viotech Electrical Pvt. Ltd. were present in the meetings.

The event was witnessed live by a lot of visitors out of which The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry coordinated and facilitated more than **150 visitors registration** and **viewing**. The companies and the viewers who took part in the event gained knowledge about the international markets and shared their thoughts with each other. The stakeholders of the 3-day expo were pleased with the efforts of TAITRA and The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry to expand the trade relations between India and Taiwan, and wished for more such events in the future.





The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry has been granted approval for organizing a Panel Discussion on "Accelerating Electric Mobility with green jobs and gender parity" on 10.11.2021 at Green Zone of COP26 in Glasgow, UK.

This year's conference aimed to reach a consensus on actions to keep global warming to 1.5 degrees Celsius (2.7 degrees Fahrenheit) above pre-industrial levels and to secure netzero emissions by 2050. At the heart of COP26, there were, negotiations involving the 197 Parties to the UNFCCC. The UK aimed to bring countries together to agree to a comprehensive, ambitious and balanced outcome that takes forward coordinated climate action and resolves key issues related to the UNFCCC, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement.

As a socially responsible organisation, The Bengal Chamber took a pledge - "As a leading and relevant representative of businesses, governments, policy, institutions and civil society in general, The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry is looking forward to working together with all stakeholders in realizing the goal of Zero Emission in the next few decades. We must all go faster and this is the motto that is driving us as we go ahead with this universal dream." said Mr. Subhodip Ghosh, Director General, The Bengal Chamber. It was released at a ceremony addressed by Mr. Alok Sharma, COP26 President.



SESSION WITH HIS EXCELLENCY ANDRE ARANHA CORREA DO LAGO, AMBASSADOR OF BRAZIL TO INDIA

The Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industry organised two sessions with His Excellency Andre Aranha Correa do Lago, Ambassador of Brazil to India on Tuesday, 16th November 2021 from 4:00 p.m. onwards at Williamson Magor Hall, The Bengal Chamber premises.

His Excellency Andre Aranha Correa do Lago, Ambassador of Brazil to India visited The Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry, along with Mr. Pradeep Khemka, Honorary Director and Treasurer of Consular Corps of Kolkata and Director, Khemka Group of Cos. His Excellency addressed a round table meet on "Built Heritage of Settlements around Kolkata". The programme started by showcasing a short film "Europe on the Ganges", followed by a presentation on "Architectural styles of Kolkata" by Mr. G M Kapur, Chairperson, Heritage Committee, BCC&I and State Convenor, INTACH and another on "Restoration of Danish Governor's house in Serampore" by Ms. Gopa Sen, Proprietor, The Designers, who has worked on restoration of Danish Governor House, Serampore.

The second session was an exclusive interactive session with His Excellency Andre Aranha Correa do Lago and senior members of the Chamber and representatives from various sectors like IT, Energy and Environment, Mining, Engineering & Manufacturing, Agriculture and Rural Development, Culture and Heritage, Education, Health and Pharmaceuticals, Shipping, and Defence, on "Potential Bilateral Synergies between India and Brazil".

H.E. Lago tried to connect the similarities between Brazil and India, how both countries adopted an essential-centric economy that have boomed in the later years by efficiently producing its own essentials for the population, cheap and standard quality food, cars, clothing etc. Both of them are not competitors but are extremely complimentary to each other. He also mentioned about India's incredible revolution as the world leaders in the sectors of IT and Pharma.

His Excellency shared his views on how Brazil and India can work together on aspects of reducing GHG emissions, water

conservation as Brazil brought a revolution in agri-tech, using innovative techniques that give the information about the right use of fertilizers and reduction in the use of chemicals. The Brazilian Ambassador was very keen to establish stronger ties between Bengal and Brazil, remembering the emotional connect of Football, especially admirers of Pele and supporters of the Brazilian national football team here in the lands of Bengal. His Excellency also announced that the Brazilian Embassy in India is going to organise a Large quiz on football with the schools of Kolkata, New Delhi. For which they are planning to bring Zico to India for the finals of that quiz. He

tried to emphasize that India has a great scope in the Brazilian market for investments and collaborations. His Excellency concluded the session with the message that for both countries bilateral trade, joint ventures will be beneficial and as Brazil is working on technologies that bring social justice, India can adopt these and can work jointly towards sustainable economic development.

The programme was supported by G S Marketing Associates. It was widely appreciated by all the senior members of The Bengal Chamber and was well covered by media.


















Webinar on "Powder Metallurgy (PM)": 03.11.2021







presentation on the basic concepts of information technology and cyber security that would be essential for a better and a holistic grasp of the concepts based on the principles of cyber technology. This session stood out in its simplicity and relevance.

3. **Prof. Anirban Mazumder**, Professor, The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences Professor Mazumdar presented a very simple and direct, yet immensely informative and enlightening talk upon the issue of jurisdiction issues upon cyber space which continues to remain one of the most contentious cyber legal issues till date. The main thrust in the

session was with regard to the current judicial trend with reference to this issue and the legal responses to the same both locally as well as internationally

- 4. Professor Sarfaraz Ahamed Khan, Professor, The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences- have shared his knowledge with us regarding How cyber crimes affect human rights Prof. Khan spoke on how internet is extensively used in order to commit gross violations of human rights. He also explained how cyber law and technology can in turn be used to fight such violations effectively and how technology can be instrumental in the meaningful restoration of human rights of the victims of human rights violation.
- 5. **Dr. Rakesh Kumar Dhar Dubey**, Dean Law, JIS University Dr. Dubey set the tone of the FDP through a short but informative introduction that gave a hint of what we were to expect from the FDP. He talked about the various ranges of topic that the FDP is slated to touch upon and the topics that would form the main thrust of the FDP.
- 6. Dr. Diganta Biswas, PG Council, Law Department, Raiganj University – He enlightened us on Right to be forgotten Prof. Biswas talked about how having a strong information technology infrastructure does not necessarily imply that all information is always available for eternity and we should forget about anonymity and being away from the spotlight.
- 7. **Dr. Faisal Fasih**, Assistant Professor, The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences for making the session so interesting on **Breach of privacy in the social media** Prof. Fasih spoke upon the very interesting and relevant topic of privacy in the social media: an issue that assumes greater relevance with every passing day. He spoke at length at the various legal risks that people may unwillingly exposed themselves to by an unfettered use of the internet particularly the social media. He also touched upon the administrative stance in the matter.
- 8. Mr. Bikash Barai, Co-founder @ Fire Compass Continuous Automated Red Teaming (CART) & Attack Surface Management sharing with us his expertise and idea on Fireside chat on emerging cyber security trends This was a technical session in which a large number of doubts that law students might have with regard to the technical aspects of information technology was cleared. The session stood out in its simplicity despite being essentially technical in nature.

- 9. Mr. Ayan Dutta, Inspector of Police, Bank Security Fraud Branch, Central Bureau of Investigation, Govt. of India enriching us on Problems in cyber crime detection. Mr. Dutta shared his immense experience on the various techniques used by fraudsters to defraud people online, the various ways in which banking frauds are committed or banking security systems are breached.
- 10. Mr. Sandeep Sengupta, Founder / Director ISOAH; CISA, Lead Auditor (ISO27001, ISO22301, Privacy, GDPR), Security Consultant, Entrepreneur his awareness session on how to avoid cyber crimes. Mr. Sengupta spoke extensively on cyber crimes and how the same can be detected by non-technical persons. He demonstrated first hand how cyber crimes are actually affected by criminals and how the crimes are designed in such a manner that detection would be almost impossible for non-technical persons.
- 11. Mr. Soumyajit Raha, Special Public Prosecutor, Cyber Crime, Government of West Bengal discussing a very interesting topic AI and the law Mr. Raha touched upon the very novel and interesting topic of Artificial Intelligence and the law and he spoke at length about excessive usage and/or dependence upon artificial intelligence might render human intervention in legal cases redundant in the future. However, a few people in the audience were of the view that although AI was useful and more accurate in several respects it can never completely replace human faculty, at least in cases that require extensive human discretion.
- 12. Mr. Shubhendu Chakraborty, Cyber Security Centre of Excellence, Department of IT & Electronics, Govt of West Bengal fulfilling us with his knowledge on Unique features of cyber crimes and Evaluating the existing cyber crime grievance redressal mechanism. This session was in the nature of the procedural and investigation aspects of cyber crimes stressing upon the various impediments faced by the investigators upon the detection and resolution of cyber crimes from an investigation perspective.


Major Events Organized in Department of CE (October 2021 – Till Date)








4. Depart of Civil Engineering, SurTech has organized a physical Industry Visit for the
