E-vehicle charging stns at old tram depots soon: Min

Kolkata: The state government is planning to convert the old tram depots of the city into electric vehicle charging stations to introduce more electric-run vehicles.

The transport department is also planning to introduce 1,000 electric buses in the city by April next year.

State transport and housing department minister Firhad Hakim inaugurated the three-day electric vehicle carnival, organised by New Town Kolkata Development Authority (NKDA), at Eco Park on Friday evening. The carnival that demonstrates the use of various e-vehicles will conclude on Sunday. Hakim said that the government is trying to phase out fuel-run vehicles from the streets gradually.

"We are going to set up electric vehicle (EV) charging

stations across the city. The old tram depots will be converted into EV charging stations. We are looking for more spaces in KMC areas to set up EV charging stations. In the next three to four months, Kolkata and its adjacent areas will have enough EV charging stations. We have already introduced two EV charging stations in Kolkata and will have 100 more such stations in the

city soon," Hakim added.

The civic authorities of New Town will ink an MoU with their counterparts in a British town that has excelled in promoting e-vehicles.

The NKDA chairman, Debashis Sen, said they will develop a centre of excellence to promote electric vehicles. The state government has already come up with an electric vehicle policy.

'State proposes to add 3K e-buses by 2030'

KOLKATA: The state government proposes to introduce 3000 e-buses by 2030, Firhad hakim, state Transport minister said on Friday.

Hakim inaugurated a threeday e-vehicle carnival organised jointly by New Town Kolkata Development Authority (NKDA) and Bengal Chamber of Commerce and Industry at New Town. The venue of the carnival is opposite gate number I of Eco Park.

Hakim said there are 80 e-buses that are plying in Kolkata. The number will go up

to 1000 by the end of 2021-22 financial year or latest by early 2022-23 financial year, he said. He said the state govern-

ment had taken a pledge to give cleaner and greener Bengal and e-vehicles will pay a major role to bring down the pollution level. Two charging stations will come up in Kolkata and later 100 others will be built. He said discussions regarding the matter is on with CESC. Hakim congratulated Debashis Sen, chairman of NKDA for being one of the early users of e-vehicles.

More than 35 stalls have been set up by the vehicle manufacturers, banks, utility companies, charging solutions. The entry to the carnival is free. There will discussions every day to create awareness about e-vehicles. The manufacturers will answer the questions of the visitors. Publication: Anandabazar Patrika

To further the State's transition to Green Transport, the Electric Vehicle (EV) Policy 2021, has been announced by The West Bengal Government, aiming to position the State as a sustainable transportation infrastructure hub. Through the move, the State government is promoting electric mobility in the State. The policy will remain in force for five years from the date of notification in the official gazette. West Bengal has made global benchmark in EV in public transport, with E buses, as reported by International Energy Agency; a Paris based autonomous intergovernmental organization.
